SUPERSTAR ARIES SETS SAIL FROM SINGAPORE, WITH NEW ITINERARIES FOR MAY & JUNE 2003

Star Cruises, "The First Global Cruise Line" and "The Leading Cruise Line in Asia-Pacific" wishes to announce new itineraries for **SuperStar Aries** departing from Singapore, for the months of May and June 2003. After nearly a month of dry dock at the Sembawang Shipyard, the **SuperStar Aries** has commenced cruises from Singapore to nearby ports in Malaysia since April. From 18 May 2003, she will embark on new voyages to Malacca, Kuantan, Kuala Lumpur, Pulau Tioman and Penang, for a limited period till end June 2003.

In announcing these itineraries, Star Cruises Chief Operating Officer Mr. Chong Chee Tut highlighted the introduction of *SuperStar Aries* to the Singapore market as an option to fill the void created by SuperStar Virgo's current deployment to Perth, Australia which has now been extended till mid-July.

"SuperStar Aries serves as an ideal interim option in terms of passenger capacity particularly in this current market environment. We believe that it would take some time for the number of holiday cruisers to return to the levels prior to the deteriorated conditions," added Mr Chong.

SuperStar Aries' has undergone refurbishment and upgrading of facilities during dry dock. The recreational and wellness areas have been further enhanced and now include an indoor jacuzzi pool and reflexology centre, while new private karaoke rooms with the latest sound equipment are added to the Europa Lounge. It should be noted that fresh air is available all over the ship and at the open-space decks. The air-conditioning system operates on a 100% intake of fresh air instead of recycled air.
