STAR CRUISES EXTENDS AMENDED ITINERARIES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

Further to the Company's release dated 27th December 2004 in relation to the amendment of **SuperStar Virgo's** and **SuperStar Gemini's** itineraries where calls to Phuket have been cancelled, Star Cruises wishes to inform that the amended itineraries for both ships' respective **3-night cruises** will be extended **from Sunday, 2nd January 2005 sailings until further notice.**

This comes in the wake of Star Cruises' continual monitoring of the situation in Phuket and the decision today to defer cruises to the *tsunami*-hit destination until further notice.

Passengers who are currently cruising on **SuperStar Virgo** and **SuperStar Gemini** on the amended itineraries are safe. The cruise and shore excursion activities in Langkawi and Penang have been smooth and incident-free as areas damaged by the *tsunami* are isolated. Both ships are expected to arrive in Singapore and Port Klang tomorrow as scheduled.
