Various products using Yukisio has even become standard Okinawan souvenirs for visitors!

Sea-Sky Hakuai

- **Kurima Bridge & Ryugujo Observatory** – The 1,690-meter Kurima Bridge, completed in 1995 for connecting Miyako and Kurima Islands. It is the longest farm road bridge in Japan. You could find a colourful sea view Seen from the bridge, the colors of the sea change kaleidoscopically depending on the angle of light, beautiful beyond words. The view of Yonaha Maehama and Kurima Islands is also fantastic. We cannot fail to recommend it as a great spot for a drive or for a stroll.
- **Maehama Beach** – When you see the white sand and the length of Maehama beach, which is well contrasted by the emerald-green ocean, you feel as if you are truly in paradise. It stretches seven kilometres and is suited for swimming and various other water sports. It usually leads rankings of Japan's best beaches.
- **Aeon MaxValu** – Popular shopping destination for many locals and visitor. The property includes supermarket and Pharmacy.
- **Semi-Submersible Vessel Sea-Sky Hakuai** – Sea-Sky Hakuai is a semi-submersible vessel in which passengers can observe the depths of the ocean near the south part of Miyakojima. The seawater is incredibly clear. Let's take a look at the beautiful undersea world of Miyakojima! (This attraction is not recommended for handicapped passengers or occupy with wheelchair. - **Ueno German Culture Village(Outside visit)** – The Ueno German Culture Village found its origin in the Meiji Era (1868-1912), when a shipwreck occurred on the Miyako coastline. Locals rescued the German crew, and a theme replica was built to commemorate this event. With a replica of the German Marksburg Castle, this theme park inter-mixes German culture with the beauty of Miyako Island to create an Okinawan German fairy tale. Guest can enjoy the Museum of Philanthropy visit up to 8th floor observatory level.

- **Higashi Henna Cape** –It is designated as a National Historic, Scenic and Natural Monument, and the great panoramic view from the lighthouse. This is not only one of the most scenic places in Okinawa but is also among the 100 most beautiful areas in Japan. The 2km long cape is surrounded by deep blue ocean water and Easter lilies bloom beautifully in the early spring. You can view the East China sea to the north and the Pacific Ocean to the south.
- **Shigira Lift Ocean Sky** (include one way cable car ride) – Full length 283 meter long cable car was just opened in April 2016. You could enjoy the beautiful blue sea and colourful landscape surrounded by beautiful nature without unobstructed from the air.
- **Aeon MaxValu** – Popular shopping destination for many locals and visitor. The property includes supermarket and Pharmacy.

Tooriike Pond

- **Irabu Bridge & Makiyama Observatory** – The Miyako-Irabu bridge took about nine years to complete. The main bridge span is 3,540 meters and cost \$38 billion to build for connecting five islands. It is a longest toll-free bridge in the country. Makiyama Observatory is a highest observatory in the island which can see Kurima and Ikema Island.
- **Tooriike Pond** – A mysterious, naturally-formed pond created by the erosion of limestone by rain. The fresh water of the pond is connected to sea water, making it a unique diving spot. It is designated an Okinawa natural monument.
- **Toguchi-no-hama Beach** – Located between Irabu-jima and Shimoji-jima Islands, Toguchinohama Beach is closer to the more “populated” area in the center of the two islands. The sand on this beach is so fine and white. The water is crystal clear and clean. Toguchinohama Beach is on the list of the top 100 beaches in Japan and is a popular beach with the local residents on the Islands.

Shureimon

- **Shuri Castle 、 Shureimon** (outside visit) – **Shuri Castle** is a gusuku (Okinawan) style Japanese Castle which dates back to the 14th century, and was constructed by the Ryukyu kingdom. Shuri Castle contained the palace of the Ryukyu Kingdom. **Shureimon** is one the main gate of Shuri Castle. The gate reflects strong Chinese influence, alongside indigenous religious traditions. The four Chinese characters framed on the gate - Shu, rei, no, and kuni, which mean 'Land of Propriety' - were added to the gate long after it was built. The structure of the gate is similar to that of Chinese three-bay turret gates, and is covered with a red hip-and-gable tiled roof.
- **Pharmacy** – Enjoy some shopping in local pharmacy where you can find health products, cosmetics, drugs and groceries.
- **Shin-toshin Omoromachi** – It is a fashionable shopping and commercial district. Frequented by young people, families and tourists, the area has large stores selling high end designer fashion goods and brand name items at stores such as; Tsutaya, Toys R Us, Best Denki (electronics store), Duty Free, Co-op market, San-A (super market). The area also has many restaurants and a movie theater.
- **Kokusaidori** – It is the main shopping precinct in Naha, with souvenir shops, cafes, restaurants and fashion boutiques along both sides. Historically Kokusaidori was known as 'The Miracle Mile' because of its rapid recovery after World War II.

Glass Bottom Boat

It is interesting to see clownfish, moorish idol, wrasse, blue damselfish, and other beautiful fish swimming in the tropical ocean. (This attraction is not recommended for handicapped passengers or occupy with wheelchair. Passengers can enjoy and take photo at the beach nearby.)
 - **Okashigoten Confectionary Factory Line** – original Beni-imo tarts are made in the line factory where you can get to see its final process of manufacturing through the window in the shop, and where you can find the famous Okinawan sweets products such as Beniimo Tart and purple yam cream.
 - **Manzamou** – named by the King Shoukei of the Ryukyu Dynasty, Manzamou means an area of grass to sit 10,000 people. The cliff is located in the middle of the coast of Okinawa Main Island and looks like an elephant's nose. The plateau above it is made of raised ancient coral reefs beaten by the waves. Most of the plants you see around this area are designated as special natural treasures. The view from the cliff, 15 to 20 meter above the sea, is breath-taking but you must be careful not to miss the trail.
 - **Mihama American Village** – the entertainment complex' theme of Americana provides a nostalgic pleasure for residents of the bases as well as an interesting diversion for the locals. The Mihama American Village resembles a big American outdoor shopping mall with lots of shops, restaurants and cafes. The most recognizable feature of the American Village is the large Ferris wheel.
 - **Pharmacy** – Enjoy some shopping in local pharmacy where you can find health products, cosmetics, drugs and groceries.
