- **Sea Canoeing** – Start canoeing upon arrival at Ko Panak and Ko Hong. Sea canoeing is one of the best ways to explore the fascinating and beautiful limestone karst islands and caves of Phang Nga Bay. Inside the “Hong” (an open-to-the-sky lagoon inside a limestone islet) you will admire mangroves sprouting all around, and shrubs and trees struggling up rock crevasses. After Canoeing, you can enjoy swimming from the boat before returning to Phuket.

** Tour includes 2 caves for canoeing, approx. 30mins in each cave (Each Canoe carries 2 guests with a paddler)

- **Promthep Cape** – Most photographs of the stunningly beautiful sunset in Phuket were taken here. Located at the south-most tip of Phuket island offers a memorable and spectacular view of the Andaman Sea. (Takes about 50 steps up to viewpoint)
- **Big Buddha** – Enshrined in the top of Nak Kerd Hill is Phra Yai (The Big Buddha) referring to the size of this Phuket’s largest statue of Lord Buddha. The 45-meter-tall Buddha statue was structured with reinforced concrete and then covered up the surface with white marbles so it sits sparkling underneath the sun. (Takes about 80 steps up to Big Buddha Statue)
- **Wat Chalong** – It is the most famous and sacred temple in Phuket as it was the residence of a respected monk Luang Po Cham, who took part helping people during the Chinese Coolie Rebellion in 1876 during the reign of King Rama V.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant.
