Batu Caves

Its main attraction is the large statue of the Hindu God at the entrance, besides a steep 272 climb up its steps to finally view the stunning skyline of the city centre. (Need to climb 272 steps up to the main temple. This attraction is not recommended for handicapped passengers or occupy with wheelchair. Passengers can enjoy and take photo at nearby area).
- **AEON Mall Bukit Tinggi** – The AEON Bukit Tinggi Shopping Centre is also popularly known as JUSCO Bukit Tinggi, it is one of the largest AEON (JUSCO) shopping centre in Malaysia. With the theme, "Experience The Difference", this mall is one of the shopping complex with over 160 retail outlets. JUSCO Supermarket, restaurants, cafes, food court, leisure and entertainment stores, cinemas, sports and book stores can be found in the shopping mall.

Perdana Putra

- **Perdana Putra** – houses the main administrative offices of the Prime Minister, Deputy Prime Minister, Ministers and Deputy Ministers in the Prime Minister’s Department, Chief Secretary to the Government as well as the Special Units. It features striking green domes and its main block is decorated with stone carvings and wrought iron with motifs of the bunga raya or hibiscus, the national flower. A combination of Islamic and Mogul architecture, this majestic structure overlooks the picturesque Lake Putrajaya.
- **Putrajaya International Convention Center** (photo stop) – the design idea of this unique and impressive building is based on the shape of the eye of 'pending perak' (a silver Malay royal belt buckle). From the front view, the building's eaves or wings are lifted at the sides, creating broad overhanging over the raking wall.
- **Putra Mosque** – the stately Putra Mosque is one of Putrajaya’s most famous landmarks and three quarter of the beautiful mosque floats on the Putrajaya Lake. It has a unique pink dome which is constructed from rose-tinted granite and comprises of a prayer hall, the sahn or courtyard, learning facilities and function rooms. The mosque accommodates 15,000 worshippers and boasts a 116-metre, five-tiered minaret, the tallest in the region.
- **IOI City Mall** – located in the South of Klang Valley with an all-round connectivity. Its built-up area enveloping a 1.5 million sq. ft. of lettable space is occupied by exciting fashion brands, supermarket, cineplexes, and exquisite dining experiences.
